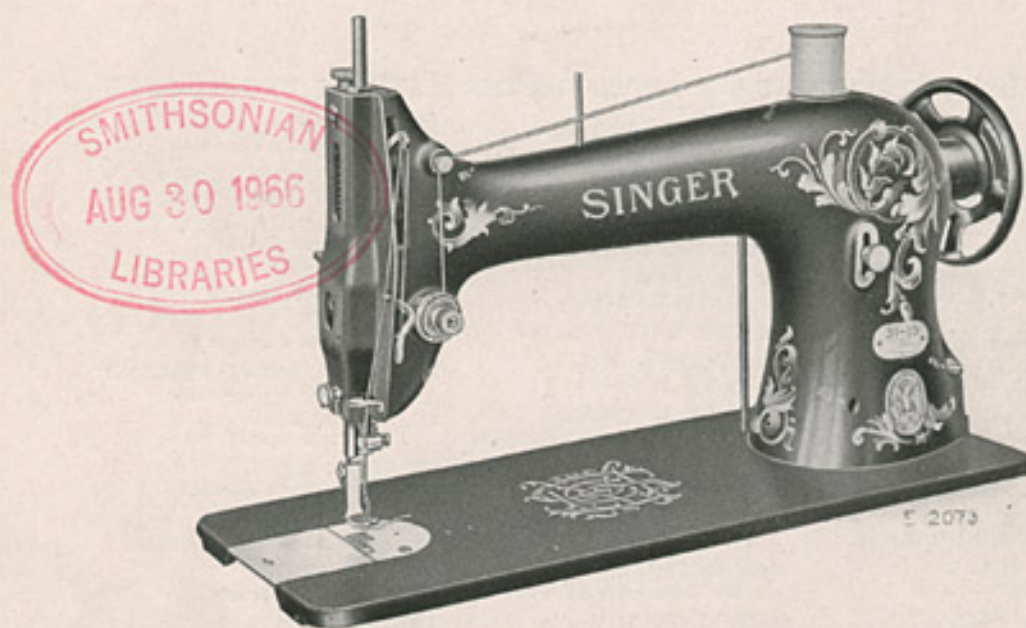

Machine No. 31-15

Machine No. 31-15 has one needle and an oscillating shuttle and makes the lock stitch. This machine is adapted for use on all descriptions of fabrics and is successfully used in the manufacture of a great variety of articles, including:

Suits
Cloaks
Overcoats
Overalls
Uniforms
Skirts

Shirts
Shirt Waists
Dresses
Corsets
Bathing Suits
Mackintoshes

Lap Robes
Bedding
Blankets
Upholstery
Oiled Clothing

Clothing factories and tailoring establishments use Machine No. 31-15 extensively and find it indispensable for general clothing manufacture. Perfect lock stitches are made on the machine and excellent work is accomplished. There is a clear working space of 10¼ inches at the right of the needle so that large work is easily handled. The machine has a drop feed and the presser foot can be raised either by hand or by means of a knee lifter which is regularly furnished for the purpose.

The machine can be operated either by foot power or mechanical power, and it is capable of being driven up to the high speed of 2200 stitches per minute. When it is desired to operate the machine by foot power, treadle stand No. 25265 and table No. 5412 can be furnished at an extra cost. This outfit is strongly constructed and convenient to operate.
