

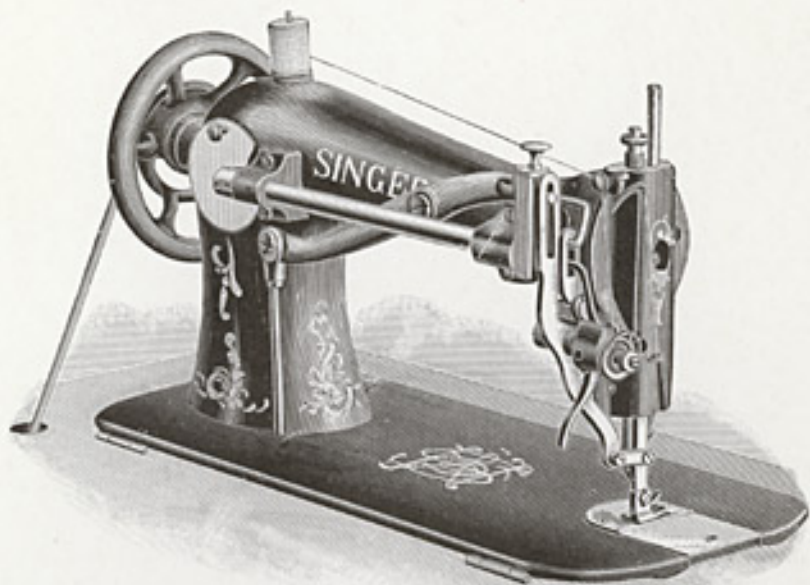

Machine No. 16-88

Machine No. 16-88 is designed for sewing cloth or light or medium weight leather and is successfully used in the manufacture of automobile curtains, waterproof covers, bags, tarpaulins, leather leggins, carriage trimming, etc.

The machine has one needle and an oscillating shuttle and makes the lock stitch. There is a clear working space of $10\frac{1}{2}$ inches at the right of the needle, so that large work can be readily handled.

It is equipped with upper and under feeding mechanism each of which can be adjusted independently. By this means the upper or lower plies of fabric being sewn can be fed faster or slower as may be desired. This feature is particularly valuable when fabrics of varying texture are being sewn.

Binding, hemming and piping are efficiently accomplished on the machine. Two styles of piping attachments can be furnished, one of which, No. 36367 folds both edges of the strip. The other No. 36068, also folds both edges of the strip and in addition turns one of the edges under. The attachments will be supplied when ordered, an extra charge being made. Samples of the materials to be handled should accompany all orders for attachments.

The machine can be driven by mechanical power up to the speed of 1400 stitches per minute and it can also be operated by foot power. When it is desired to operate the machine by foot power, treadle stand No. 25265 and table No. 5401 can be furnished, an extra charge being made for this equipment.
