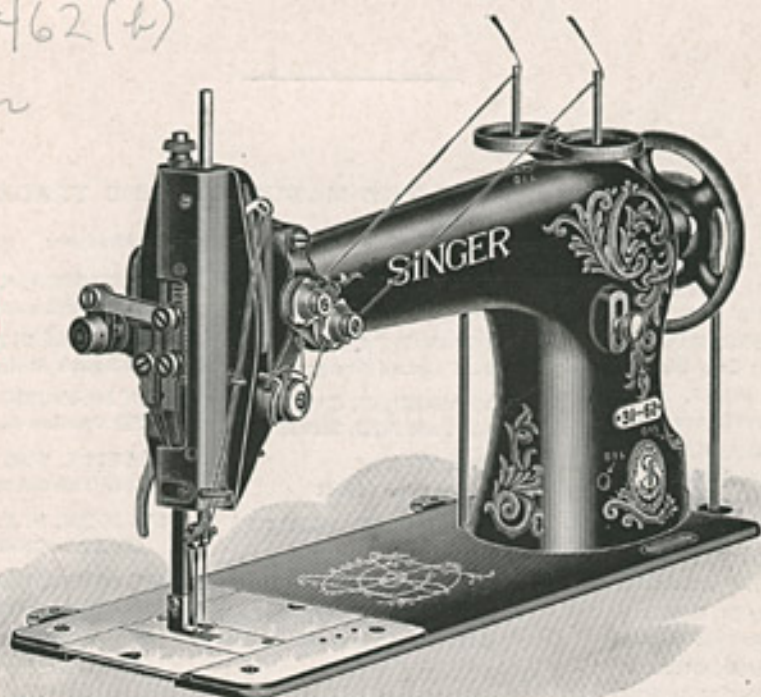

Singer Machine No. 31-62 has alternating pressers and is for use in light and medium weight fabrics; it is especially useful for binding blankets, bedticks, cloaks, corsets, insoles, lap robes and many other articles requiring the use of alternating pressers. Its needles may be gauged from $\frac{3}{8}$ inch to $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches apart, as ordered, and its throat plate is flush with the bed-plate. The maximum speed recommended is 2000 revolutions per minute at which a large production is assured.

The machine is also successfully used for folding and attaching a band to the bottom of knee pants at one operation, the necessary fittings for this work being furnished, on order, at a charge extra to the machine. A machine of $\frac{5}{8}$ inch needle gauge is generally used for the banding

operation. As Machine No. 31-62 will accomplish the work which formerly required five single needle machines, its use assures a great saving of money, and for this reason it is preferred by manufacturers of knee pants.

The bed of this machine is $18\frac{3}{4}$ inches long, and the clear space from needle to base of arm is $10\frac{1}{4}$ inches.
