Detachable Head— A Big Feature

THE Morrison "Perfection" No. 5-A is equipped with the type of head illustrated at the right—a detachable head that will satisfy the most exacting demands.

With it the complete stitching unit can be removed for adjustment when necessary.

Removal of plate discloses entire Cutting, Forming and Driving Operation. This is the only machine on the market on which this can be done.

Feed tube is attached to cutter block eliminating any possibility of wire buckling.


Wire is gripped firmly from time it enters feed roller until stitch is driven.

The shoe is operated by a compression spring which comes into action only when needed.

Although machine is such a small efficient unit, cutting knives are same type and size as used in Nos. 3-H and 3-J.

Entirely New Clutch

The illustration on the opposite page gives a good view of the new clutch—please note that there are no clutch bodies or plates; instead a noiseless Cone clutch which will over-run if machine is jammed by needless operation.



Stitch Adjustment

By simply turning thumb screws on top of head any size of stitch can be secured. This is not an arbitrary adjustment—it can be made at any time and as often as desired.
