

Thorax a good deal narrower than the elytra, transverse, the sides greatly narrowed behind, definitely and closely punctured, rather shining, the impressions broad and distinct though not deep. Scutellum not visible. Elytra broad, rather short, but a good deal longer than the thorax, closely and coarsely punctate, a little shining, almost without pubescence. Hind body scarcely visibly punctate. Three examples.

This species is readily recognizable by the definite, quite distinct, punctuation of the thorax, a very unusual character in this genus.
