

*Hab.* MEXICO, Tampico in Tamaulipas (*Schwarz, in U.S. Nat. Mus.*).

Two examples (one of which has been presented to us), found on Dec. 21st. A very small, remarkably distinct form, with the elytra explanate at the apex somewhat as in *Pentarthrum apicale*, Broun, and with a blunt tooth-like prominence on the outer margin near the tip. *P. caudatum* is related to *P. phlæophagoides*, Woll.
