*Hab.* MEXICO (*Truqui*)<sup>1</sup>.

12. **Trichoxys sulphurifer.**

*Clytus (Trichoxys) sulphurifer*, Chevr. Ann. Soc. Ent. Fr. 1860, p. 470, t. 9. f. 4<sup>1</sup>.

*Hab.* MEXICO<sup>1</sup>, near the capital (*Flohr*).

13. **Trichoxys westwoodi.**

*Clytus (Trichoxys) westwoodii*, Chevr. Ann. Soc. Ent. Fr. 1860, p. 471<sup>1</sup>.

*Hab.* MEXICO, Oaxaca<sup>1</sup>.

14. **Trichoxys abbreviatus.**

In hoc genere brevis, niger, viridi-incumbentipubescens, elytris utrinque fasciis indistinctis, a latere versus discum extensis, dubus vel tribus pallidioribus, interspatiis duobus nigris; ventre nigro utrinque maculis magnis quatuor viridi-pubescentibus; tibiis et tarsis rufis; thorace fere orbiculari; elytris carinis fortibus, utrinque in spinam apicalem desinentibus; mesosterno prominente, antice verticali.

*Hab.* GUATEMALA, Purula (*Champion*).

15. **Trichoxys tricolor.**

*Clytus tricolor*, Chevr. Col. du Mexique, 1<sup>re</sup> cent. fasc. 4; Lap. & Gory, Mon. Clyt. p. 89, t. 16. f. 103.

*Clytus (Anthoboscus) tricolor*, Chevr. Ann. Soc. Ent. Fr. 1860, p. 483<sup>1</sup>.

*Hab.* MEXICO, Cordova, Vera Cruz<sup>1</sup>; GUATEMALA, San Gerónimo (*Champion*).

This pretty little species is especially ill-placed in *Anthoboscus* (= *Clytanthus*), to which Chevrolat referred it. The depressed sutural area of the elytra, bounded by a longitudinal carina, shows that its position is near *Cyllene* or *Trichoxys*. In colours it has no resemblance to any other species, except perhaps *Cyllene chara* of Say. The mesosternum, although not prominent and vertical, as in the typical *Trichoxys*, is decidedly convex. It may be regarded as an aberrant or degraded form of this genus.
