

## CLYTUS.

*Clytus*, Laicharting, Verz. Tyrol. Insekt. ii. p. 88 (1784) ; Lacordaire, Gen. Col. ix. p. 67.

This genus, in the restricted sense adopted by Lacordaire, is represented chiefly by species of the north temperate zone, both in the New and Old World. Of the two following Mexican species I know only *C. dimidiaticornis*, which is a true *Clytus* allied to the European *C. floralis*.

*Hab.* MEXICO, La Parada, Oaxaca (*Sallé*<sup>1</sup>), near the capital (*Flohr*).

## CLYTANTHUS.

*Clytus*, Serville, White et auct. veter.

A numerous genus, comprising upwards of fifty species, found chiefly in north temperate latitudes and in the northern tropical zone of the Old World. Dr. Leconte mentions only two species as occurring in the United States ; and none are recorded from South America or Tropical Africa, although one or two are known from South Africa.

1. ***Clytanthus clathratus*.**

3. ***Clytanthus anthophilus*.**

*Hab.* MEXICO, La Parada, Oaxaca (*Sallé*<sup>1</sup>).

4. ***Clytanthus nigropunctatus*.**

*Hab.* MEXICO (*Truqui*).
